### 1 Waitrose

*"Now, bring us some figgy pudding"*

The area around Clifton Triangle is buzzing with culture, history, great shopping. For Christmas gifts, stop off at Space NK or L'Occitane.

### 2 Wills Memorial Building

*"Silver bells"*

Grab yourself a takeaway hot chocolate from Mrs Potts Chocolate House, or coffee from Soho Coffee Co, to keep you warm as you explore the trail. Hungry? Woky Ko serve creative Asian dishes.

### 3 Woodland Road

*"Driving Home for Christmas"*

Grab a bite to eat at Yakinori or a festive drink at The White Heart on Park Street Avenue before you cut back onto Park Street to explore more illuminations.

### 4 St George's Bristol

*"Deck the halls with boughs of holly"*

St George's is one of the country's finest concert halls, based just off Park Street. After a busy day shopping, head over and enjoy one of the amazing upcoming events.

### 5 Bristol Beacon

*"Hark! The Herald Angels Sing"*

Bristol Beacon is the city's largest concert hall and audiences have been enjoying music here since 1867. Enjoy the projection whilst cosy and warm in Bambalan.

### 6 SS Great Britain

*"On Christmas day, On Christmas Day"*

The ship was the world's first great ocean liner and brainchild of our most famous honorary Bristolian, Isambard Kingdom Brunel.

### 7 Hargreaves Lansdown

*"Chestnuts roasting on an open fire"*

This part of the city really comes alive at Christmas with the Vintage Winter Wonderland, and plenty of bars and restaurants. Choose from pizza at Prezzo, Latin American flavours at Las Iguanas and more.

### 8 Arnolfini

*"Five gold rings"*

The city's historic harbour is packed with family-friendly attractions. Head to Arnolfini and enjoy some locally-sourced food and drink overlooking the waterfront.

### 9 King William Ale House

*"Merry Christmas ya filthy animal"*

The 'King Billy' forms part of Bristol's 'Beermuda Triangle'; a series of excellent craft beer bars which stock brews from a number of Bristol breweries.

### 10 Premier Inn Bristol City Centre

*"Happy Christmas to all, and to all a good-night"*

This hotel on Lewins Mead is located in a historic area of the city, just a short walk away from The Lanes; home of boutique bowling, karaoke and more.

### 11 All Saints' Church

*"Ding Dong Merrily on High"*

Discover some of Corn Street's fantastic restaurants by heading to Four Wise Monkeys, Cosy Club, Pho or Franco Manca.

### 12 Revolutions Vodka Bar

*"We kissed on the corner then danced through the night"*

Grab a drink and have a dance here, The Mother's Ruin, Mr Wolf's or another of the many bars in the Old City.

### 13 Zara

*"Dashing through the snow"*

Cabot Circus is a great destination for Christmas shopping with everything from department stores to independent shops.

### 14 H&M

*"It's the most wonderful time of the year"*

You'll find this projection just outside H&M, but don't look up to the sky! Keep your eyes low to the ground for this festive sight.

### 15 Quakers Friars

*"Let it snow, let it snow, let it snow"*

Quakers Friars provides a stylish area to explore. Discover The Enchanted Snow Maze until December 23rd.

### 16 Bristol City Centre Marriott

*"Santa baby, so hurry down the chimney tonight"*

Have you been to the Marriott's Cast Iron Bar & Grill? A great spot for a special treat, with globally-inspired cuisine in a vibrant part of Bristol.

### 17 Castle Park Embankment

*"Simply having a wonderful Christmas time"*

Make your way to Castle Bridge to view this illumination. Follow with an evening tipple at Le Vignoble and enjoy your wine matched with continental tapas.

### 18 Bella Vista

*"Sleigh bells ring, are you listening?"*

Bella Vista is an authentic Italian restaurant. Stop by for a taste of their Christmas menu and a peek at their unbeatable view.

### 19 Bevan Brittan LLP

*"May your days be merry and bright"*

"Best seen from St Philip's Bridge this area is full of unique bars and eateries. You'll be spoilt for choice with the likes of Bo-cabar and Left Handed Giant nearby.

### 20 Unity Sexual Health Centre

*"Run, run Rudolph"*

You'll find this illumination projected onto Unity Sexual Health Centre, who provide key health and well-being services to the community. Best viewed from BIMM on Passage Street.

### 21 Church Of St Thomas the Martyr

*"So here it is, Merry Christmas"*

You'll find these iconic lyrics projected onto this church. Next door you'll find The Fleece; legendary live music and club night venue since 1982.

### 22 The Distillery

*"Rockin' around the Christmas tree"*

The Distillery is a striking new office development in Glassfields and this illumination is best viewed from Leonardo Hotel.

### 23 NatWest Accelerator

*"Have a holly jolly Christmas"*

View this illumination from Glass Wharf. A whole host of hotels are only a stone's throw from this thriving business quarter, including the Hilton Garden Inn.

### 24 Meads Reach Bridge

*"Santa Claus is Coming to Town"*

Located close to the Meads Reach Bridge by Glass Wharf, those coming into Temple Meads will be able to tick off an illumination right away!
