

BID Objectives



Report Overview

This report has been produced to give an overview of the ongoing cleansing and graffiti removal carried out by the Redcliffe & Temple BID within it's boundary.



Executive Summary

This section summarises the key areas and tasks covered during the past month. Further detail on each work activity and location is included within this report.

February was another busy month for the Cleansing team ensuring pavement areas, high contact locations and levy payer premises were kept clean and inviting. The cleansing team completed their thorough deep clean of the pavements of Victoria Street and the next focus is on jet washing the pavements of Redcliff Street. There is a notable amount of unwanted graffiti and tagging within the area and the team removed 199 items of graffiti from over 124 different locations. The team are working very hard to carry out removal of unwanted graffiti promptly and efficiently, ensuring that levy payer's building facades and the BID area street furniture are restored back to a clean state.

Deep Cleansing

Summary of monthly activity.

The Cleansing Team completed the deep clean of Victoria Street's pavements. The next focus will be on the pavements of Redcliffe Street. The team continue their regular checks of hotspot areas and responded to several Levy Payers requests that needed support. The Bristol Light Festival is coming to the area for the first time and the team did a brilliant job deep cleaning one of the viewing points.






Graffiti

Summary of monthly activity

The cleansing team utilised their skills and training in the removal of graffiti, using chemicals and specialist equipment to remove stubborn graffiti and use certain products to help reduce the risk of repeat tagging in certain areas.

*note that an occurrence constitutes a job or single incident of graffiti. Each occurrence may contain various graffiti items to be removed i.e. 1 occurrence and 4 items / tags of graffiti may need removing.
